

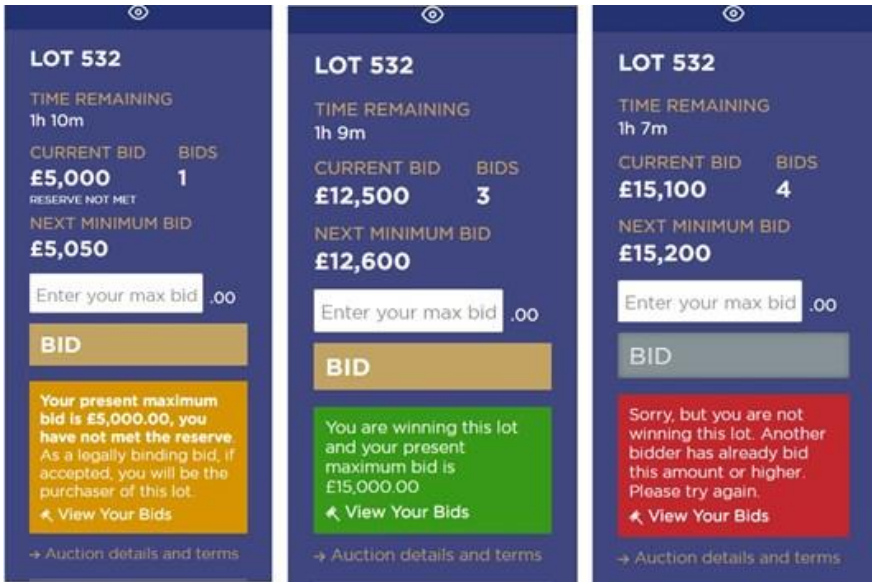
HOW TO REGISTER FOR TIMED ONLINE AUCTION

1. Visit www.brightwells.com
2. Click onto Timed Online Auction of Hay, Straw, Silage, Haylage, Beet & Maize Silage
3. In the top right-hand corner, click onto 'LOG IN' and sign in if you already have account. If not, please 'Create a Brightwells Live Account'.

4. After placing a bidding deposit of £500, click onto the Lot(s) you wish to purchase and put in your highest bid you would be prepared to go to, at your earliest opportunity. Waiting to bid until the final few seconds may be risk, if others also bidding at that time.
5. When bidding, the system treats your bid differently depending on whether the Vendor has placed a reserve price on the lot.
If your bid has the value up to or at the reserve, the bid will be taken at it's maximum to the reserve.
If the lot has no reserve or if your bid is forced above the reserve by other bidders, then an increment table operates that the system follows, similar to other bidding platforms. The bidding will automatically increase your bid in increments outbidding other bidders up to your maximum bid.
You will be notified by email and under your Brightwells 'My Bids Page' if you have been outbid, so you can decide whether to bid more.
